

BEEF CATTLE GENERAL REGULATIONS

1. Entry fee shall be 10 per cent of 1st prize.
2. The cattle committees shall have the authority to have removed from the barn any animal that they think is not suitable for showing to the public.
3. All animals shall be shown in the ring and exhibitors must be ready to bring them out when called for.
4. Proof of registrations must be available if called for. PHOTOCOPIES ACCEPTED.
5. Full particulars and Canadian registration numbers must be given for every animal entered.
6. Tampering with cattle, unnatural practices in fitting will not be tolerated and cattle entered for competition shall be presented in the show ring in their natural conformation and natural physical condition.
7. Breeding capability - In a case where doubt exists in the mind of the judge or official as to the breeding capability of an animal the exhibitor may be required to furnish evidence to the satisfaction of the official concerned.
8. Calves must be tattooed and papers applied for.
9. Only cattle entered in the show may be stalled in the barns.
10. Classes will be split at ten entries.

IF ANY PROTEST is received regarding the acceptance of any exhibit or the placing thereof, the Directors will meet on Tuesday, August 3, at 2:00 p.m. for the express purpose of dealing with such protest.

Exhibitors are particularly requested to read **ALL** the Rules.

LIABILITY: All exhibitors shall be under the control and direction of the Agricultural Society but solely at the risk of said exhibitor. The Ag. Society will not be responsible for damage, injury, loss or theft. Each exhibitor will be solely responsible for any loss, injury or damage done to, administered by or arising from any animal or article exhibited by him, for its description as given in this catalogue. This shall indemnify the Ag. Society against all legal or other proceedings in regard thereto.

PRIZE MONEY - 1ST -\$20, 2ND -\$17, 3RD -\$14, 4TH -\$12, 5TH -\$10, 6TH -\$8, 7TH - \$6.

RULES:

1. The entry must be in the exhibitor's name, family name, or parent's name on registration papers. If a 4-H project, must have appropriate ear tag.
2. Eligible ages: under 10 as of show day.....Peewee
10-21 as of show day.....Junior
3. The only people allowed to groom the entry will be the Junior showing the animal with assistance from other Juniors only.
4. Showmanship and Grooming are combined, and will be judged as one. No entry fee for Showmanship, ribbons only.
5. All ages are as of Show Day.
6. **Two-year-old animals must be owned and entered in Junior's name**, or have been shown in a 4-H project as a yearling. Purebred calves must have a tattoo.
7. Calendar year calves may be shown separately, e.g. in class 110 and also with their dam in class 112.

Limited to one entry per class.

Registered or grade, entries must have been routinely cared for by the exhibitor.

Veterinary requirements in above classes same as in Senior Classes.

1st and 2nd place winners of above classes will compete for Grand Champion and Reserve Champion Bull.
