## HALL EXHIBITS RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. **ENTRIES CLOSE JULY, 22<sup>nd</sup>**. One week prior to the fair.
2. All sections in Hall Exhibits are open for entry to Exhibitors from THE ENTIRE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA and that portion of Saskatchewan lying within a radius of 100 miles of Vermilion.
3. Exhibitors in Hall Exhibits are not required to be members of the Society, although they are cordially invited to become members. Membership is \$1.00 per year. **No exhibitor may show more than one exhibit in any one sector.**
4. Entries **MUST** be listed in the order shown in the prize list. Note: **A separate Entry Form must be filled out by every exhibitor.**
5. The directors may require any exhibitor, if the question is raised, to make a statutory declaration that the **work exhibited is of his/her own making** and has not previously been shown at the Vermilion Fair. Exhibits must be fresh and clean.
6. Articles shown in collections cannot be shown in single classes or vice versa. No article will be judged in more than one section.
7. The judges are instructed not to award prizes unless the articles are deemed worthy of merit or to articles borrowed or purchased for competition or to those incorrectly named or listed. Articles defaced by wear are not eligible for competition.
8. The judges will cut all loaves and cakes and open all exhibits shown in jars.
9. **Tags must be picked up at the office prior to the Fair, and must be attached to the exhibits, before bringing to the Exhibit Hall.**
10. EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE: of the fair. **All exhibits must be in place between 9:00 a.m. & 12 Noon Wednesday, July 28<sup>th</sup>, and must not be removed from the building before 6:00 p.m. of the last day of the fair.** This rule will be strictly enforced in order that all patrons of the Fair may have the opportunity of viewing the exhibits. Judging will be at 1:00 p.m. Wednesday, July 28<sup>th</sup>. **Exhibit Hall will be closed at 6:00 p.m. on the last day of the Fair; exhibits to be picked up AND prize money collected not later than 8:00 p.m. Exhibits may also be picked up on Sunday between 9:00 a.m. & 11:00 a.m.** Exhibitors must be accompanied by a director when picking up exhibits. "Please arrange to have someone pick up exhibits if you are unable to do so."
11. If any questions in connection with any of the above rules are raised, an exhibitor may be required by the Directors to make a statutory declaration that the work exhibited complies with the rules out lined.

12. The Directors, while taking every precaution, cannot hold themselves responsible for damages to or loss of exhibits. The Society is not insured to cover loss or damages.
13. **All merchandise prizes must be claimed in the year won.**
14. Soiled or unfinished articles will not be accepted or entered for prizes by the Directors in charge. Wearing apparel exhibited may have been worn, but must have been cleaned and pressed.
15. The Exhibit Hall will be open the following times:  
Thursday from Noon until 9 p.m.  
Friday from 11 a.m. until 9 p.m.  
Saturday from 11 a.m. until 6 p.m.
16. The parade will be on July 29<sup>th</sup> at 11 a.m.
17. The summer hours of the Vermilion Agricultural Society office will be Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. until 4:30 p.m.

Sheaves of fodder should not be stripped of foliage as this is one of the chief points considered in judging.
