

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

### **SHEEP COMMITTEE: CHAIRMAN- CHARLENE CAREY**

**ENTRY FEE:** \$2.00 per class. \$20 per pen of three market lambs. **Entries close July 17, 2010.**

**ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE TIME:** All sheep competing in the Sheep Show must be on the grounds before 10:00 A.M. Thursday, July 29, 2010 and must be kept on the grounds until 7:00 p.m., Friday, July 30, 2010.

The Youth Sheep Show is open to showmen under 21 years. The age of the exhibitor is taken as of the date of the show. All entries in the Youth Sheep Show must be owned and cared for by the exhibitor. Proof of ownership should be available, if requested, at time of the show. Animals may be either purebred or crossbred.

**Each exhibitor is allowed one (1) entry in each class. No animal may be shown in more than one class.**

All attendants showing sheep must be neatly dressed. Exhibitors failing to comply with this regulation will be refused entry into the ring with their sheep. Advertising of exhibitor's name or farm on clothing is not permitted in the show ring.

All sheep entered in the Sheep Show must be clean, tail docked, castrated (except for ram lamb and rams shown in the flock class) and trimmed prior to the show. All sheep shown in short fleece (staple less than one inch or 2.5 cm.)

No ribbons or awards won before the show may be displayed until after the completion of the Youth show.

**Directors reserve the right to correct any error or make any alterations to the regulations in the prize list. Any exhibitor lodging a protest must make it in writing with proof to substantiate the protest included, and it must be delivered to the Secretary before the close of the show. It must also be accompanied with a deposit of \$50.00 cash, which will be forfeited to the Society if the protest is not sustained. The protest will be reviewed at the first organized committee meeting following the show.**

**LIABILITY: All exhibitors shall be under the control and direction of the Ag. Society but solely at the risk of said exhibitor. The Ag. Society will not be responsible for damage, injury, loss or theft of or to any exhibit, irrespective of the cause of such damage, injury, loss or theft. Each exhibitor will be solely responsible for any loss, injury or damage done to, administered by or arising from any animal or article exhibited by him, for its description as given in the catalogue. This shall indemnify the Agricultural Society against all legal or other proceedings in regard thereto.**

All animals must have CSIP tags

Class: # 50 Open to all breeders. All lambs must be clean, tail docked, castrated and trimmed prior to the show. All sheep must be shown in short fleece (staple less than 1 inch or 2.5 cm.)

-Arrival and Departure Time: Arrive before 10:00 A.M. Thursday, July 29 and must be kept on grounds until 7:00 P.M. Friday, July 30.

-All attendants showing sheep must be neatly dressed.

-Advertising of exhibitor's name or farm on clothing is not permitted in the show.

-All animals may be either purebred or crossbred.

**-Animals exhibited in the pen of three market lambs are not eligible to be shown in other classes.**
